




RETAINING WALL PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

Each retaining wall constructed in the City of Tukwila requires a building permit in accordance with section 105 of the current Washington State Adopted Building Codes.

- All retaining walls constructed shall have a minimum of a 12-inch embedment into the soil, to anchor and be supported below the frost depth for our region.
- Please note that ornamental designs anchored to the wall will be included in the total height when determining if a permit is required.
- No retaining wall placed in a Critical Area in accordance with TMC 18.45 shall be exempt from permit.
- Walls over 4 feet in height (measured to the bottom of the footing) without a surcharge and walls with a surcharge over 2 feet in height.







PERMIT EXEMPTION

The following exemptions from permit may apply to your project:

- 1. Retaining walls not over 4 feet tall are exempt from permit, unless supporting a surcharge that is within a 45-degree angle of the bottom of the footing. This exemption does not apply to engineered systems.
 - a. No retaining wall that is more than 36 inches above finished grade shall be exempt from permit.
- 2. Retaining walls less than 24 inches in height and are supporting a surcharge are exempt from building permit.
 - No retaining wall that is more than 12 inches above finished grade and supporting a surcharge shall be exempt from permit.
- 3. Walls up to 4 feet in height (measured to the bottom of the footing) without a surcharge and walls up to 2 feet in height supporting a surcharge.





Note: All retaining walls must be properly drained; International Residential Code, Section R404.4

Retaining Walls

Retaining walls are additionally regulated by Tukwila Municipal Code Title 18 – Zoning as follows:

TMC 18.06.800 - Structure

"Structure" means a combination of materials constructed and erected permanently on the ground or attached to something having a permanent location on the ground, but excluding all forms of vehicles even though immobilized. Not included are residential fences up to six feet in height, retaining walls or rockeries with up to four feet of exposed face, and similar improvements of minor character.

Structures, which includes retaining walls four feet and higher, are not permitted within required yard setbacks for a given property unless a Retaining Wall Setback Waiver is provided as outline below:

18.50.150 - Retaining Wall Setback Waiver

Retaining walls with an exposed height greater than four feet may be allowed in required front, side or rear yard setbacks as a Type 2 Special Permission decision to the Community Development Director under the following circumstances:

- 1. When the applicant's property is on the lower side of the retaining wall and it is not visible from adjacent properties or is screened by landscaping; or
- 2. When a wall built on a property line or perpendicular to it benefits the lots on both sides, and the owners of both properties agree to jointly maintain the wall; or
- 3. When a wall in a front yard is required due to roadway expansion or improvements.
