

FENCES AND FENCES ON CONCRETE WALLS

Fences over 6 feet high require a building permit and fences over 8 feet high require professional design engineer. Retaining walls holding over 4 feet of backfill require a permit and engineering.




RETAINING WALLS OVER 4 FEET HIGH

Retaining walls over 4 feet high and made of the following material types must be permitted and be designed by a professional engineer.

- Retaining concrete walls.
- Retaining modular block walls.
- Retaining stone walls (or rockeries)
- Stone Rockeries (maximum allowed height of 6 feet).

A Geotechnical report is required for these types. Your application must also include a plan for erosion prevention and permanent stabilization of disturbed soil (contact Public Works Department).



REFERENCES:

Refer to Tukwila Municipal Code (TMC) for additional requirements when:

- 1. Exposed wall is greater than 4' high. (TMC 18.06.800 & 18.50.150)
- 2. Wall will be located on the property line or on adjacent property. (TMC 18.06.800)

Refer to Tukwila Municipal Code Title 18.50.150. for Retaining Wall Setback Waiver.

Retaining walls with an exposed height greater than four feet may be allowed in required front, side or rear yard setbacks as a Type 2 Special Permission decision to the Community Development Director under the following circumstances:

- 1. When the applicant's property is on the lower side of the retaining wall and it is not visible from adjacent properties or is screened by landscaping; or
- 2. When a wall built on a property line or perpendicular to it benefits the lots on both sides, and the owners of both properties agree to jointly maintain the wall; or
- 3. When a wall in a front yard is required due to roadway expansion or improvements.
